There are several elements that unite us but, in particular, the passion that moves us, as the will to realize a desire, a dream, a vision.






OUR PHILOSOPHY

Our effort is to produce wines that can talk about this important Cru of the Castles of Jesi: Rosora, so immensely heterogeneous in every corner of its land, overlooking the sea but lulled by the slopes of the mountain.

That's why we focus all our attention on the care of the vineyards, with the aim of protecting soil biodiversity, by practicing a sustainable agriculture. This allows our plants to fight diseases, withstand environmental stress and give us grapes with perfect ripening balances.

Once the grapes have matured correctly, we dedicate to the harvest that is made strictly by hand, to preserve the quality and integrity of the bunches.

The production, intentionally selected, relies on the meticulous care of the workers in the cellar, where the master are steel and vitrified concrete tanks. Rosora, a small town nestled in the hills, lands of Verdicchio, is situated in central Italy, between the Sibillini Mountains and the Adriatic Sea, in the Marche region. It is there that the vineyards where Croce del Moro was born, at 450 mt above sea level. The Municipality of Rosora is located on the left bank of the Esino River, and is part of the twenty-five Castles of Jesi, the ancient medieval centers situated on the highest point of the hills.





## THE NEW PROJECT

## MORO DELLA GENGA VERDICCHIO DEI CASTELLI DI JESI

Verdicchio since immemorial times, is considered the king of Italian white wines. Just a sip of it is enough to feel all its power and distinctive aroma. The remarkable acidity, which is maintained over the years, is given by its slow maturation and the considerable temperature ranges between day and night, favored by the mountain air coming from the Central Apennines, specially during the summer season.

This is why our wines enjoy an elegant and sophisticated balance between structure and acidity, body and flavor. Amazing is the evolutionary capacity of the wine, that can surprise years later, after long aging in bottle.
