- Roditis “Ale pou” (=fox) with a reddish skin color

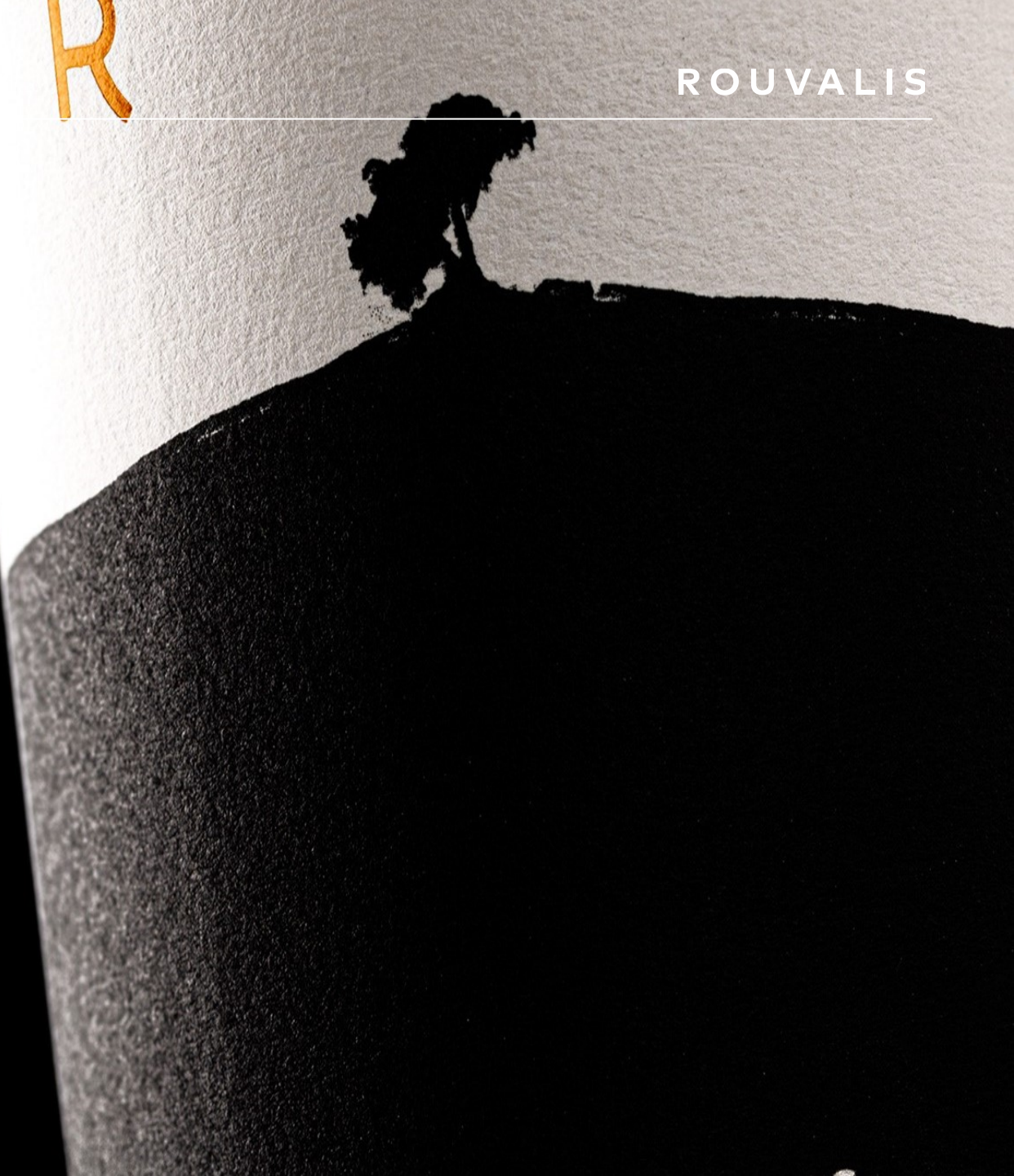

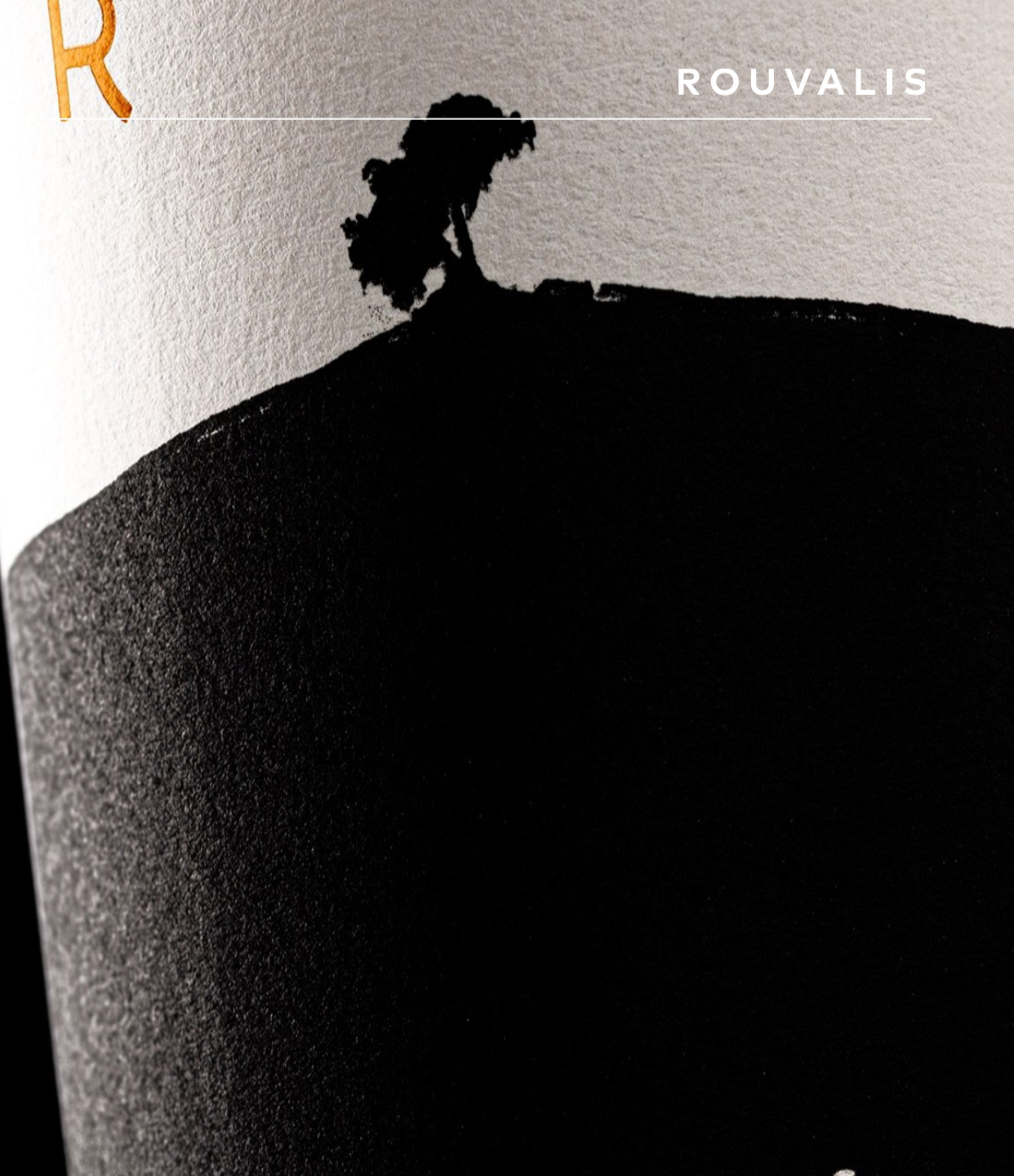

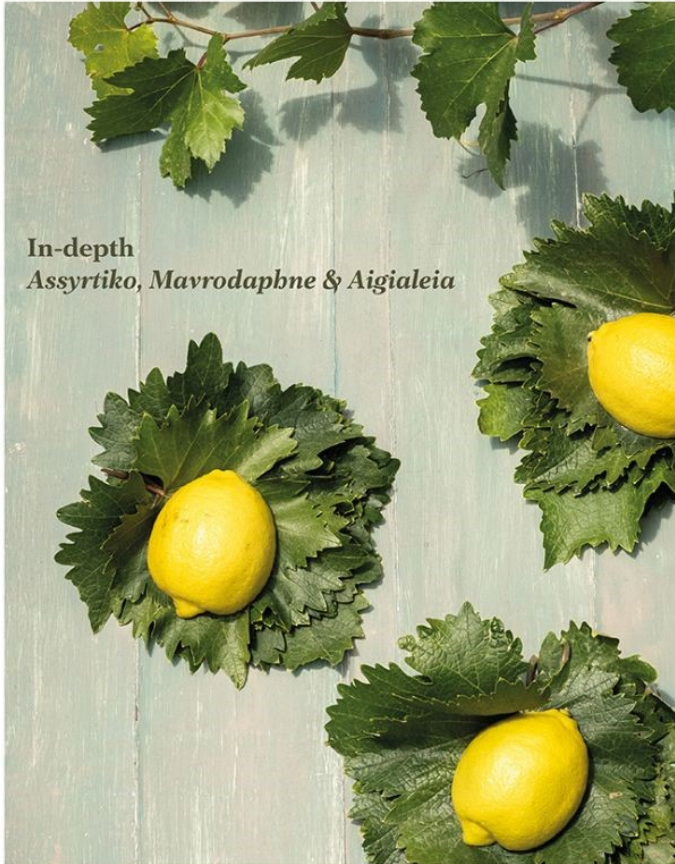
